Parade Safety Precautions- Rules and Regulations

- All Drivers must provide a valid proof of liability insurance with registration form.
- All drivers must possess a valid driver license during parade.
- Drivers shall have a clear field of vision that encompasses 180 degrees and provides a view in front and to each side of the vehicle.
- The towing vehicle shall have a functioning horn and brakes that are in good working order.
- Towed floats shall have safety chains attached to the towing vehicle.
- Parade floats shall maintain a 30 foot interval between other entries in front of them with speed not faster than 5mph.
- All sitting float riders shall remain seated.
- Standing float riders shall have body support and firmly grasp hand holds and rails.
- No person shall jump off or onto a moving float.
- Float riders shall not throw any items to spectators. Items (i.e. flags and stickers) may be distributed to spectators by hand from parade participants walking alongside the floats.
- No Flyers or written materials are to be distributed along the parade route.
- No candy should be distributed at any time.
- Float riders shall not spray water or other fluids at spectators.
- All materials used on entries must be flame retardant.
- Smoking is prohibited prior and during participation in the parade.
- Alcohol consumption prior to and during participation in the parade is prohibited.
- Firearms and weapons are prohibited.
- Parade participants are responsible to pick up their own debris.
- Parade participants shall put safety first at all times for themselves and spectators.
- Entries will be subject to inspection by Fire Department.
- All equestrian entries must have full control of horse throughout the entire parade route.
- Equestrian units must have a clean-up person in keeping with the entry.
